FIRST AMENDMENT TO WORK ORDER NO. 1 BETWEEN THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AND ADA ENGINEERING, INC.

This First Amendment to ADA Engineering Work Order No. 1 made and entered into this <u>20</u> day of <u>February</u>, <u>2017</u>, by and between the City of Doral, Florida, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida ("City") and ADA Engineering, Inc. ("Consultant") having its place of business at 8550 NW 33rd Street, Suite 202, Miami, FL 33122, for the provision of Professional Services for the design for the Year 7 of the Canal Bank Stabilization Program.

WHEREAS, the City of Doral is presently engaged in the design of the Year 7 of the Canal Bank Stabilization Program; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources (RER) has reviewed the 90% design plans and has provided comments to address that is outside the current scope of work with the Consultant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Doral is presently contracted with ADA Engineering for the design of Year 7 of the Canal Bank Stabilization Program and due to additional information requested by RER during the plans review process, a revision to the original design scope of work is necessary; and

WHEREAS, the original cost for the design services for Year 7 of the Canal Bank Stabilization Program approved by the Work Order was a not to exceed amount of \$219,927.74; and

WHEREAS, the cost for the provision of design services was increased to a not exceed amount of \$245,461.44 for the addition of the design services for the Year 7 of the Canal Bank Stabilization Program, with the cost of the amended work to be a not to exceed amount of \$25,533.70; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 16-187 was awarded and adopted entering into an agreement with ADA Engineering for Program Management of Year 7 of the Canal Bank Stabilization Program, in an amount not to exceed \$400,000.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants set forth in this First Amendment, the parties agree as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Amendments. The following Sections of the Work Order are hereby amended to read as follows:

"SCOPE OF SERVICES AND SCHEDULE:

...The performance of services associated with this Work Order will be executed on a time and material basis with a not to exceed amount of \$219,927.74 \$245,461.44."

EXCEPT AS PROVIDED HEREIN, all other terms and conditions of the Contract dated January 30, 2018, remain in full force and effect.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE RANKINGS OF **RESPONDENTS** TO RFQ #2016-19 "CANAL BANK **STABILIZATION PROGRAM MANAGEMENT** YEAR **AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER** INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ADA ENGINEERING, THE TOP RANKED FIRM, SUBJECT TO APPROVAL AS TO FORM AND LEGAL SUFFICIENCY BY THE CITY ATTORNEY, FOR THE PROVISION OF PROGRAM MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR YEAR 7 OF THE CANAL BANK STABILIZATION PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$400,000.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE SUCCESSIVE RANKED FIRMS IF AN AGREEMENT CAN NOT BE REACHED WITH THE TOP RANKED FIRM FOR NO MORE THAN THE NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT: AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER **EXPEND** BUDGETED TO **FUNDS** FURTHERANCE HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in response to Request For Qualifications #2016-19 (the "RFQ") for "Canal Bank Stabilization Program Management: Year 7" (the "Project"), the City of Doral (the "City") received four (4) submittals by the July 28, 2016 deadline with all four (4) firms meeting the required criteria; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the qualifications, ADA Engineering, was considered the most qualified, responsive and responsible proposer (the "Contractor"); and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council approve the rankings of the respondents, authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with ADA Engineering for the provision of Program Management services for Year 7 of the Canal Bank Stabilization Program, which includes design and CEI (Construction, Engineering, Inspection) services, in an amount not to exceed \$400,000.00, and to expend budgeted funds in furtherance hereof; and

WHEREAS, in the event an agreement cannot be successfully negotiated with ADA Engineering, Staff further requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with the next successive ranked firm for the same not to exceed price.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Approval.</u> The rankings of the respondents to the RFQ as follows is hereby approved:

- 1. ADA ENGINEERING
- 2. TYLIN INTERNATIONAL
- 3. JOHNSON ENGINEERING
- 4. GIANGRANDE ENGINEERING

The approval of these rankings does not confer any rights on any of the respondents.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and enter into an agreement with ADA Engineering, the top-ranked firm, subject to approval by the City Attorney as to form and legal sufficiency, for the provision of Program Management of Year 7 of the Canal Bank Stabilization Program, in an amount not to exceed \$400,000.00. The City Council further authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with next successively ranked respondent if an agreement can not be reached with the top-ranked firm, also in an amount not to exceed \$400,000.00

in the event that an agreement cannot be negotiated with ADA Engineering. The City Manager is authorized to expend budgeted funds in furtherance hereof.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Implementation.</u> The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and the provisions of this Resolution.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.



After the 90% design submittal, RER requested that the top of back be raised at or above the County Flood Criteria Elevation, which has not been requested for Canal Bank Remediation and Stabilization Design for Years 1 through 6. In addition, this design criteria was not included as part of the original design scope of work.

To address this specific RER comment, the 90% design submittal has to be revised completely. The following are the required modifications to the 90% design submittal for the Northline Canal between NW 97th and NW 87th Avenue (approximately 5,165 LF of canal) and approximately 1,555 LF of canal section between the Village of Doral Lakes residential community (NW 51st Terrace) and Hole #1 of the Silver Fox Golf Course:

- 1. Revise typical section sheets (2 sheets)
- 2. Revise design plan sheets (13 sheets)
- 3. Revise canal cross section sheets (26 sheets)
- 4. Revise detail sheets (2 sheet)
- 5. Revise summary of quantity sheet (1 sheets)
- 6. Revise cost estimate
- 7. Evaluate impacts to historical flow rights by raising the canal top of bank
- 8. Attend two additional meetings with RER

SCHEDULE

ADA will complete the work outlined above in accordance with the City current bid schedule.

COMPENSATION

ADA will be compensated for the 90% re-design services described above on a time and material basis not to exceed \$25,533.70, in accordance with the General Engineering/Architectural Services (RFQ 2016-19) agreement between the City and ADA. The attached man-hour/fee estimate shows the hours and costs associated with the 90% re-design effort.

Total design cost including the redesign effort is \$245,461.44, based on the original design fee of \$219,9127.74 as outlined in the February 20, 2017, Professional Services Agreement between the City and ADA.
