- 3. RETURN OF GOODS Credit may be allowed for goods returned with prior approval. A deduction may be made from credits issued to cover cost of handling.

- 8. WAIVER The failure of Graybar to insist upon the performance of any of the terms or conditions of this agreement or to exercise any right hereunder shall not be deemed to be a waiver of such terms, conditions, or rights in the future, nor shall it be deemed to be a waiver of any other term, condition, or right under this agreement.
- 9. MODIFICATION OF TERMS AND CONDITIONS These terms and conditions supersede all other communications, negotiations, and prior oral or written statements regarding the subject matter of these terms and conditions. No change, modification, rescission, discharge, abandonment, or waiver of these terms and conditions shall be binding upon Graybar unless made in writing and signed on its behalf by a duly authorized representative of Graybar. - 13. ASSIGNMENT Buyer shall not assign its rights or delegate its duties hereunder or any interest herein without the prior written consent of Graybar, and any such assignment, without such consent, shall be void.

 14. GENERAL PROVISIONS All typographical or clerical errors made by Graybar in any quotation, scknowledgment or publication are subject to correction. This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Missouri applicable to contracts to be formed and fully performed within the State of Missouri, without giving effect to the choice or conflicts of law provisions thereof. All suits arising from or concerning this agreement shall be filed in the Circuit Court of St. Louis County, Missouri, or the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Missouri, and no other place unless otherwise determined in Graybar's sole discretion. Buyer hereby irrevocably consents to the jurisdiction of such court or courts and agrees to appear in any such action upon written notice thereof.
- 15. PAYMENT TERMS Payment terms shall be as stated on Graybar's invoice or as otherwise mutually agreed. As a condition of the sales agreement, a monthly service charge of the lesser of 1-1/2% or the maximum permitted by law may be added to all accounts not paid by net due date. Visa, MasterCard, American Express, and Discover credit cards are accepted at point of purchase only.
- 16. EXPORTING Buyer acknowledges that this order and the performance thereof are subject to compliance with any and all applicable United States laws, regulations, or orders. Buyer agrees to comply with all such laws, regulations, and orders, including, if applicable, all requirements of the International Traffic in Arms Regulations and/or the Export Administration Act, as may be amended. Buyer further agrees that if the export laws are applicable, it will not disclose or re-export any technical data received under this order to any countries for which the United States government requires an export license or other supporting documentation at the time of export or transfer, unless Buyer has obtained prior written authorization from the United States Office of Export Control or other authority responsible for such matters.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING A WORK ORDER BETWEEN THE CITY OF DORAL AND GRAYBAR ELECTRIC COMPANY, INC. TO DESIGN AND INSTALL UPGRADED LIGHTING FIXTURES AND ASSOCIATED CONTROL SYSTEMS FOR THE GOVERNMENT CENTER COUNCIL CHAMBERS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$26,989.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS IN FURTHERANCE HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, as the City continues to grow, there is a need for the City's Government Center to adapt, transform, and improve building systems in order to ensure staff can provide the community better service and to accommodate the needs of a growing City staff; and

WHEREAS, the City of Doral facilities are equipped with different electrical, lighting, data communications and security components; the different systems periodically need repairs, maintenance and upgrades to maintain all facilities to meet building energy efficiency standards and to reduce daily electric consumption; and

WHEREAS, in 2019, the PWD Facility Maintenance Division team started to upgrade old lighting technology installed at the Government Center to high efficiency LED technology; this work was completed by in-house technicians; and

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2018 the Mayor and the City Council Members adopted the contract between the City of Kansas City, Missouri Contract No. EV 2370 and Graybar through US Communities via Resolution No. 18-157; and

WHEREAS, the PWD requested a quote from Graybar for the upgrade of the Council Chamber Theater Metal Halide Lighting Fixtures to LED Theater Lighting Fixtures

and controls based on the adopted Contract No. EV2370; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department (PWD) respectfully requests the Mayor and the City Council-Members to authorize the City Manager to execute the work order enclosed as part of "Exhibit A" for Graybar Electric Company, Inc. to provide professional services to design and install upgrade lighting fixtures and associated control systems for the Government Center Council Chamber in an amount not to exceed \$26,989.00; and

WHEREAS, funds for these services are budgeted in the current Fiscal Year Public Works Fund, Line Item "Electrical Contract Building / Lighting Repairs", Account Number 001.80005.500460.
