11	sign variance	to permit a third detached sign on the property located at 8651 NW 13 Terrace in the
12	City of Doral	, Florida; and
13	WHE	REAS, on March 23, 2005, the City Council held a quasi-judicial hearing and received
14	testimony and	d evidence related to the application from the Applicant and other persons and found as
15	follows:	
16	Findings of Facts:	
17	1.	The Wal-Mart/Sam's Club shopping center currently has two 200 square foot
8	common tena	nt signs on the premises;
19	2.	A rezoning of the site was approved for Wal-Mart and Sam's Club, which share the
20	shopping cen	ter and are both anchors existing in one shopping center;
21	3.	The Code provides that shopping centers which front on two streets at a corner and
22	which size ex	ceeds 500 feet in lineal frontage are allowed two signs and one monument sign;
23	4.	Staff has analyzed this location and has found that, although the two streets which it
24	fronts are not	perpendicular, this site functions in the same manner as sites which are located on two
25	street fronts;	
26	5.	The property has an 832.25 foot frontage on NW 87 Avenue and contains one sign
27	within that di	stance and a frontage of 1040 feet on NW 84 Avenue and also contains one sign;
28	6.	A monument sign at this location would serve to highlight tenants on an interior out
29	parcel which are not already being promoted on the main pylon signs;	
30	7.	The applicant requested approval of a sign of 57.47 square feet;

5	Section 1. Wal-Mart Stores, Inc. is hereby granted a sign variance to permit a third		
6	detached sign on the property located at 8651 NW 13 Terrace, Doral, Florida, subject to the		
7	following conditions:		
8	1. The plan shall be generally consistent with Exhibit "A," attached hereto and made a		
9	part of this Resolution. The space currently showing a directional arrow may have the copy		
10	substituted with another tenant at permitting.		
11	2. The sign shall be placed in a location as to meet all sight triangle criteria and to		
12	maintain safety.		
13	3. The sign shall be properly landscaped with at least 4 feet radius of low shrubbery		
4	around the sign and maintained in a professional manner.		
15	4. The sign shall be created in a manner to prevent pedestrians from accessing electrical		
16	components and in a design to prevent vandalism.		
17	5. The sign shall be maintained in a good working order. Failure to do so may result in		
18	Code violations subject to Code Enforcement action.		
19	Section 2. This Resolution shall be recorded in the Public Records of Miami-Dade		
20	County, Florida and the Applicant shall pay the costs of recording said document.
