4. Public Comments

Ms. Ivonne Perez-Suarez is the consumer outreach coordinator for the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services. Discussion Items

a. Adult Training Program Update

Nerea informed the board that the program has been running since April of this year and there are currently 5 participants attending. It is a year-round program.

At the last meeting it was discussed that the cost might be too high for families with CDC+. So, the Parks and Recreation Department is working with the city to subsidize part of the costs and take it to Mayor and Council at a future council meeting. It would go based on what the ratio is. The city would subsidize three days, which is 50%. The parents would then have to cover the other half. If it gets approved, it will go into effect next fiscal year, which is October 2024.

The program will stay in Doral Glades Park because they must approve the sites. For the summer camp this year, it'll still be Doral Glades Park because there are currently only 5 participants in the ADT program, so it all worked out with the space. For next year, they are going to look into the possibility of having the summer camp in Doral Central Park.

b. Summer Camp Update

The Department had the summer camp registration yesterday (06/24) and it did fill up. They had a better turnout this year than the previous year. Both groups are full, and they have a waiting list for anyone else that would like to join. The age limit is 7 years old and up, but the providers work on a case-by-case basis.

c. Department Update

Nerea informed the board that they're still working on offering other programs. They still have the special Olympics, feel the beat, music and now recently, they have been doing monthly nature crafts. Once Doral Central Park opens, the department will be looking into aquatic classes for special needs.
