Where Marlin Engineering, Inc. is a prequalified provider of professional engineering services selected in accordance with Consultant Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA) requirements and approved by the City Council in November 2017 through Resolution 17-202. The work should be performed in accordance with the contract provisions contained in the Continuing Professional Services Agreement between Marlin Engineering, Inc. and the City of Doral dated February 2, 2018, and the attached Proposal dated February 17, 2020 submitted by your firm for the above referenced project.

SCOPE OF SERVICES AND SCEHDULE:

The scope of the project will be as described in the attached proposal from Marlin dated February 17, 2020. The scope includes construction engineering inspection (CEI) services during the construction phase of the roadway improvements along NW 112th Avenue between NW 25th Street and NW 34th Street. The schedule requires the work to be performed within 240 calendar days from NTP. All limitations of time set forth in this Work Order are of the essence. The performance of services associated with this Work Order will be executed on a time and materials basis with a not to exceed amount of \$109,920.00.

You are required by the Continuing Service Agreement to begin work subsequent to the execution of this Work Order, or as directed otherwise. If you fail to begin work subsequent to the execution of this Work Order, the City of Doral will be entitled to disqualify the Proposal and revoke the award.

Work Order incorporates the terms and conditions set forth in the Continuing Services Agreement dated February 2, 2018 between the parties as though fully set forth herein. In the event that any terms or conditions of this Work Order conflict with the Continuing Services Agreement, the provisions of this specific Work Order shall prevail and apply.

Work Order is not binding until the City of Doral agrees and approves this Work Order.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING A WORK ORDER BETWEEN THE CITY OF DORAL AND MARLIN ENGINEERING FOR THE PROVISION OF CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING INSPECTION (CEI) SERVICES FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS ALONG NW 112 AVENUE BETWEEN NW 25 STREET AND NW 34 STREET, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$109,920.00; RECOGNIZING THAT MARLIN ENGINEERING IS A CITY OF DORAL PRE-QUALIFIED VENDOR; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE WORK ORDER AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral Public Works Department (PWD) wishes to secure a firm to provide Construction Engineering Inspection (CEI) services for the construction of roadway improvements along NW 112th Avenue between NW 25th Street and NW 34th Street; and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded funding by the State for the construction of said improvements and due to Florida's Department of Transportation (FDOT) criteria the consulting firm that is the Engineer of Record (EOR) cannot perform the CEI services; and

WHEREAS, the City issued Invitation to Bid (ITB) #2020-13, "Roadway Improvements at NW 112th Avenue between NW 25th Street and NW 34th Street" (the "ITB"), for which the City received ten (10) responses by the April 23, 2020 submittal deadline, with all respondents being determined to be responsive and responsible; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council Members approved and adopted awarding the construction of Invitation to Bid (ITB) #2020-13, "Roadway Improvements at NW 112th Avenue between NW 25th Street and NW 34th Street" at the May 13, 2020 City of

Doral Council meeting; and

WHEREAS, the PWD requested a proposal from Marlin Engineering for the provision of Construction Engineering Inspection (CEI) services for the NW 112th Avenue (NW 25th Street-NW 34th Street) roadway improvements project; and

WHEREAS, Marlin Engineering will provide day-to-day oversight of the construction, ensuring that the improvements are constructed consistent with the approved plans; and

WHEREAS, Marlin is a pre-qualified provider of professional engineering services selected in accordance with Consultant Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA) requirements and approved by the City Council in November 2017; and

WHEREAS, City staff respectfully requests that the City Council approve Work Order No. 19 for Marlin, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", for the provision of CEI services for the construction of roadway improvements along NW 112th Avenue between NW 25th Street and NW 34th Street in an amount not to exceed \$109,920.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1. Recitals</u>. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

CONSULTANT WORK ORDER

Dear Mr. Collings,

Marlin Engineering, Inc. (MARLIN) proposes to provide the services identified below for the project entitled "NW 112th Avenue from NW 25th Street to NW 34th Street/NW 27th Street from NW 112th Avenue to NW 109th Avenue", pursuant to the Continuing Services Final Agreement provided by the City of Doral (The City) for Engineering and Architectural services, dated February 3, 2018.

I. GENERAL

Pursuant to the Scope of Work of the Continuing Services Final Agreement, MARLIN shall provide professional services in support of the City's Department of Public Works for the above mentioned project. MARLIN shall administer the contract for this project and provide field observation and oversight services to ensure construction of improvements is in reasonable close conformance to the approved contract documents and the City of Doral policies and procedures. This includes but is not limited to any coordination between governing agencies, overseeing safety concerns, and ensuring compliance with MOT plans. In addition, MARLIN will verify quantities installed by the Contractor and make payment recommendation to the City. This shall be accomplished within the following tasks:

II. SCOPE OF WORK

- A. Task 1- Monitor Contractor implementation and compliance with MOT plans along the project
 - a. Review Safety Plans and MOT plans for compliance.
 - b. Work Day review of MOT set up.
- B. Task 2- Monitor new Drainage System Installation and connections to existing structures
 - a. Oversight of installation of new structures (Inlets and Manholes).
 - b. Oversight of installation of new exfiltration trenches.
- C. Task 3- Monitor new Curb and Gutter and concrete installation by Contractor
 - a. Oversight of installation of concrete sidewalk
- D. Task 4- Monitor Milling and Resurfacing and Widening by Contractor
- E. Task 5- Monitor the signing and pavement markings installation by Contractor
 - a. Oversight of the relocation and removal of signing by Contractor
 - b. Oversight of the installation of pavement markings by Contractor
 - Task 6- Monitor the signalization installation by Contractor
 - a. Oversight of installation of loop assemblies
- F. Task 7- Monitor new lighting system installation by Contractor
 - a. Oversight of installation of conduit and conductor
 - b. Oversight of installation of light poles
- G. Task 8 Monitor installation of sod by Contractor



- H. Task 9 Monitor OSHA safety standards
 - a. Ensure that all personnel and visitors on the job site are wearing the appropriate personal protective equipment including hard hats, vests, eye protection, etc.
 - b. Ensure that all safety practices are being to adhered including "trench safety" specifically, that all proper shoring/sloping is applied when needed and ladders are in trenches are in place for ingress/egress when needed.
 - c. Ensure that all equipment (heavy and light) is operational and safe.
- I. Task 10 Generate daily reports and summarize on a weekly basis all events of relevance while performing tasks 1 to 8.
