 The meeting was called to order at 12:30 p.m.

Public members attended the meeting to express their satisfaction with the PD and the current projects.

Discussion Items

- During the most recent meeting, the Major presented valuable insights on the crime data from NIBRS for January 2022 to the year-to-date. Notably, the board requested monthly highlight reports via email and an updated organizational chart.
- One of the key discussion topics was the new vehicles currently under consideration.
 The board acknowledged that a vendor had been selected but emphasized that the
 council must approve the bid. A review of the vehicle's design was also discussed,
 with the chair suggesting that the sun's graphics be reflective to enhance its appeal.
- 5. Open Discussion

- Other key discussion topics included the patrol detail for 97th Avenue and 58th, which
 was deemed insufficient to address residents' concerns about using the bike path. The
 board proposed adding morning patrols to the patrol areas before school and late
 afternoon patrols after rush hour. The last patrol conducted from 9-10 am and 2-3 pm
 was found to be inadequate in addressing the issues.
- Moreover, updates were provided on the scooter campaign and lane changes at 58th Street and 102nd Avenue. Public affairs have initiated their campaign to assist with the scooters, and the lane changes have been updated to enhance safety.
- Finally, the board requested volunteers to assist with city activities like movie nights.
 They also requested that Ginger (K-9) be active at least one hour before the start of
 the movies to enable community interaction. Late arrivals do not allow for a proper
 response.
- The meeting also addressed parking concerns, with marked cars being observed parking in visitor spaces and causing inconvenience for those with business at the PD. The board expressed the need to develop a more structured parking plan to address these issues effectively.
- The meeting was productive and informative, with participants actively collaborating to enhance the city's safety and livability.
- 6. Discussion of Next Meeting Agenda Items.
 - Volunteer activities for the upcoming year, with a proposed plan for using volunteers, recruiting volunteers, and some general requirements for volunteers.
 - · Crime Statistics for the year to date.
