A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR THE BYRNE GRANT AVAILABLE THROUGH THE MIAMI-DADE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES; TO APPLY FOR, AMEND, RECEIVE, EXPEND \$9,153.00 FUNDS AND EXECUTE AGREEMENTS WITH THE PURPOSE OF CREATING A SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City desires to accomplish the purpose outlined in the accompanying memorandum a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, that this Council authorizes the City Manager to apply to the Byrne Grant for funds in the approximate amount of \$6,865.00; to execute such contracts and agreements as are required by this governmental body following the approval of the City Council; to execute such other contracts as will serve to further the purposes described in the funding request, following the approval of the City Council; to expend any and all monies received for that purpose described in the funding request; to receive and expend any additional funds that may become available during the term of the grant; to file and execute necessary amendments to the application for and on behalf of the City of Doral, Florida; and to exercise amendment, modification, renewal, cancellation and termination clauses of any contract and agreements on behalf of the City of Doral, Florida.
