WHEREAS, at its August 2017 Regular Meeting, the City Council for the City of Doral (the "City") adopted Ordinance 2017-14, updating regulations for the immobilization of vehicles on private property ("Booting Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the Booting Ordinance requires the City Council to set by resolution the maximum fee that may be assessed for the immobilization of vehicles on private property; and

WHEREAS, after careful deliberation, the City Council has set the fee as provided herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Maximum Fee Set .</u> The maximum fee that may be assessed for the immobilization of vehicles on private property is hereby set at \$25.00.

Section 3. Implementation. The City Manager and City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and provisions of this Resolution.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
