Several public members present, interest in supporting the Family Day Event. All public, board members, guests, and staff, introduced themselves.

5. Approval of Minutes

a. November 7, 2023

Motion to approve the November 7 meeting minutes made by Member Bautista and seconded by Member Martin. By consensus, motion passes unanimously.

6. Discussion Items

a. Family Day Event

Texas Roadhouse had expressed interest in sitting at a tent as a vendor as well as food sponsor.

Miami VA would like 2 tents and tables for all the veteran information that needs to be displayed, from LPOP and Suicide Prevention.

Outpatient Site Care and RE/MAX requested a single tent and table to share.

Share Your Heart/Victory for Youth expressed interest in a tent and table.

Big Red Bus has been removed from the sponsor list due to lack of outreach and previous years' lack of interested donors.

United Martial Arts expressed interest in a vendor tent and table along with donation table under the pavilion.

Mr. Estrada reviewed the logistics open questions for the Parks Department final support stage.

Secretary Flynn confirmed now 16 tents, 21 tables, 43 chairs, including a spare tent, table, and 2 chairs. This will be reviewed again, and updates sent to Mr. Estrada and the Parks Director by close of the evening.

No power has been requested other than the bounce house, in which they intended to bring their own generator as part of the rental.

Mr. Estrada confirmed Texas Roadhouse boxed lunches for 150, Papa John's for 25 pizzas.

Parks will provide drinks, cups, plates, napkins, from Publix.

Inflatables and DJ confirmed. Parks will provide games for kids.

Set-up can begin between 8-8:30 am. The park opens at 8 am.

Parks will provide raffle tickets to be used for food and raffle donations.

Vet Info is providing volunteers to support the Park setup, teardown, and cleanup.

Publix provided gift cards for raffle.

Bass Pro Shop provided donations through the city and a grant through Vet Info.

Sports Clips provided 6 free hair cuts to raffle.

Chaplain still unaccounted for.

Secretary Flynn has had no positive contact with Miami Dade Animal Services.

Member Martin will stop by directly and confirm attendance.

Miami Dade Fire Rescue Station 69 confirmed attendance.

Doral Police Department Motorcycle Squad unconfirmed.

Civil Air Patrol may be interested in attending, Member Martin will confirm.

US Southern Command confirmed attendance.

Fish and Wildlife Conservation confirmed attendance for tent and table, but no confirmation on boat this year.

Chair Watts noted that art work should completed well ahead of time to allow both the city to vet the information before public release, as well as US Southern Command requirement to vet the information before internal release to their staff.


